The 2026 Elevation Winter Retreat is done in partnership with local churches from the DOXA Network in Scarborough, Ontario.

Our desire is to partner together for God's Kingdom purposes to see youth impacted holistically with the mission and message of Jesus through a winter retreat. During this retreat we will be united together under the banner of God's Kingdom.

The 2026 Elevation Retreat is designed with both jr. high and high school youth in grades 6-12.

Retreat Location:

Ontario Camp of the Deaf, 236 Blackstone Crane Lake Road, Parry Sound

Cost:

- Regular Price: \$125 per person (*\$25 deposit per-person deadline Dec 22, 2025*)
- *\$50 per youth worker based on a 1:10 ratio for each gender youth attending (ex: if you have 6 females and 7 males you bring 2 youth workers, one female and one male. Any additional youth workers above your ratio will pay full price).*
- Cheques made out to: Youth Unlimited with DOXA Retreat in the Memo.

Deposit:

A \$25 deposit per person is requested to secure the number of spots your group wants to attend Elevation 2026. Space is limited; booking for groups is first come, first serve.

Transportation:

Each group is responsible for its own transportation and not included in the cost of the retreat. Many churches have coordinated transportation to keep costs lower for their students, and we encourage you to make the necessary arrangements for your group.

What to Bring: Energy and enthusiasm, Bible, Notebook, Warm Casual Clothes, Toiletries and towel, Boots and indoor Shoes/Slippers, Toboggans, Sleeping Bag and pillow.

Registration: Must be filled out by each student and adult participants for all retreat attendees.

The Importance of Small Groups

During the sessions, we will give leaders directions/questions for you to work through in your small groups of 6-8 people. A part of experiential learning is getting young people to dialogue, asking questions and learning from peers. When young people have input, they learn and own the subject matter in a much deeper way. This helps us teach according to different learning styles (feeler, doer, thinker and reflector).

Teams

All youth and leaders will be splitting into teams when they arrive at Elevation for fun competitions throughout the weekend. We ask leaders to fully participate and help in leading their groups during the variety of activities. Points will be awarded during the weekend for team participation, results from activities and games, team spirit throughout the event, etc. These teams also aid by being Serve and Clean up teams for meals and sessions. Assignments of these teams will be announced on Friday night.
